About Drama Camp

Still Hollow Players III will be acting-intensive, with guest speakers who will talk about other aspects of theatre. Campers will learn basic technique and elements of the Stanislavski Method through games and rehearsals. Campers are asked to choose and memorize a monologue for the first day of camp of no more than 1.5 minutes. There will be a mock audition on the first day of camp. This allows the student to see first hand the process of a professional audition, as well as helping the instructor gauge the needs of the camper.

About Doug Presley

Doug has worked in theatre from the age of nine to present. He worked at the Barter Theatre for two years and was cast in leading and supporting roles in such plays as "Shenandoah", "Holiday Memories", "Our Town" and "Wuthering Heights". The Richard H. Levin Memorial Award was presented to him while at Barter. Doug is regularly seen on stage with Theatre at Tusculum, as well as directing shows for his own company, Revelry Repertory Theatre. At present, Doug is directing the first ever production of his original play "Yours Truly, Jack the Ripper".
